

# Joakim Allgulander Swedish, B. 1965



Joakim Allgulander's oeuvre is characterised by a conceptual base, combined with the skill of craft and a passion for the process of creating. His work demonstrates a curiosity and desire to explore different media and techniques. Everything from the natural and artificial, new and old, to more archetypical opposites such as light and darkness.

Allgulander's work is a vast repository of data, drawn from photography, media and film, combining a range of different styles and techniques His subject matter range from landscapes from his native Sweden, such as close ups of snow covered branches and water, to the inconsequential and banal – fabric textures, snapshots and details, everyday objects. There are also paintings which express abstract emotional states implying existential or philosophical responses to the human condition such as *Lunatic*, a large- scale painting of an astronaut facing campers on the moon. The visually enticing paintings are imbued with an indelible depth of contrasts.

Allgulander's range of imagery deliberately resists categorisation. Events and ideas are not expressed explicitly, but implied through subtle hints and allusions, creating an ambiguous collage of disconnected fragments, details and various techniques. By this approach Allgulander believes that representation can only be partial and subjective, and meaning must be pieced together, like memories, through isolated fragments.
